


Confession and Absolution


I believe in God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth.



Council Meeting Notes: Here are the highlights from the council meeting held this past Tuesday:

- **Pastor's Report**: Pastor has COVID-19. He is teaching classes for school virtually into his period of isolation is completed. He will be able to return to his regular duties on Tuesday, December 21st.
- **Financial Secretary's Report**: Offerings for November were as follows: Budgetary \$9,405.00; Mission \$1,827.00; Non-Budgetary \$1,015.00 (offerings/rent). The total offerings for the month were \$12,247.00.
- **Treasurer's Report**: Disbursements in November were: Budgetary \$10,305.25; Non-Budgetary \$35,029.83. The bulk of the non-Budgetary disbursements were used to pay for the Heating & Cooling system overhaul.
- **2022 Budget:** Council is working on a recommendation for the 2022 budget. The 2022 budget should be similar to that of 2021. The council is recommending about a 3% increase to the base salary for the called workers. The final recommendation will be completed at the January council meeting.
- Annual Meeting: The annual voters' meeting will be held on January 23rd following the worship service.

Piano Removal: The piano in the sanctuary is broken beyond repair and needs to be removed. If you can help in removing it, please contact Mike Schierenbeck (920-344-9580). We would like to use volunteers rather than paying someone to remove it if possible.

LM Called Workers' Gifts: This is a way of thanking and showing our appreciation to the called workers of Luther Memorial. If you would like to make a contribution towards a monetary gift for our teacher/pastor, please place it in the designated box at the back of the church.
